## HOW TO FIND US

Kinneil Estate is located in Bo'ness. Train: The nearest railway station station is Linlithgow. Car: Travelling from the west, exit the M9 at J5 onto the A905 then take the A904 into Bo'ness.

From the east, exit at J3 onto the A803 then take the A904 into Bo'ness.
