Most visits start at the Greenrig Car park. 3 miles from the centre of Falkirk. From the centre of town follow the road signs for Slamannan. Once on Slamannan Roadtake the 3rd exit off the mini roundabout on to Lochgreen Road and continue for a mile to the car park. The trails can also be accessed from the Falkirk Wheel and Falkirk High station following the John Muir Way.


